# FutureNova - The FlipPad

The FlipPad, a medical grade case for the iPad designed by FutureNova in Chelmsford and manufactured in a factory near Oldham, is used by clinical staff when they need to keep the iPad protected and cleanable with harsh infection control chemicals. Surgical staff can use it with surgical gloves on, as well as with the Apple pen. Apple have provided consistent support to bring the FlipPad standard to their enterprise healthcare market. The company is exploring other Apple accessories for healthcare with the potential to enhance the ability of clinical teams to collect patient vital signs.

The judges praised the FlipPad as a rugged and user-friendly solution in clean room and sterile settings. The FlipPad is also venturing into new vertical markets, including food preparation, oil and gas and government sectors.
